→ Race Week Guide

Arriving in Iceland

Upon landing in Keflavik, depart to your scheduled transportation. If you are flying to Ísafjörður, take the Flybus or Strætó to the Reykjavik airport. Flybus departs after every arriving flight and are easy to locate once exiting the airport.

The Bus

We have reserved a bus for 30 people (with bike transportation) the morning of June 28 and July 4. The bus will depart Keflavik International Airport around 9am and stop in a central location in Reykjavik and in Mosfellsbær before continuing to Ísafjörður. The expected arrival time is between 3pm and 4pm. For July 4, the bus will depart from the race hotel around 9am and make a stop in a central location in Mosfellsbær and Reykjavik (if needed) before heading to Keflavik. The expected arrival time is between 3pm and 4pm.

The bus will make two stops in Ísafjörður, with the first stop being the local bike shop, Westfjords Bikes. Bikes can be dropped off and then the bus will arrive at the race hotel for check-in. You may choose to assemble your bike first, or head to the hotel for check-in. Campers should also plan to check in and pay at the hotel. The location of the hotel is [here](#).

The bike shop will have full access to tools and a bike stand or two, but expect to use your own multi-tool to do most of your assembly and borrow the larger tools that you may not have had room to pack (such as that pedal wrench). Bags must be clearly labeled and may be left at the bike shop and will be secure for the duration of the race. The bike shop is located [here](#).



First Night Accommodations

Many riders will be staying at Hotel Edda Ísafjörður, and at the Hotel Edda Ísafjörður campsite (tents only). Campervans must stay at the municipal campground located [here](#).

Race Expo Event at Dokkan Brugghús June 28, 5pm to 8pm.

Our race expo will be held at our local brewery, [Dokkan Brugghús](#).

The first step when you arrive is to sign a waiver in person before receiving your race packet. Packets include printed information such as a race map and goods from our sponsors. If you have rented a GPS device from the race, you can pick this up as well.

Next, grab a beverage and a meal (not included in registration fee) from the bar and meet your fellow riders and sponsors of the race! **A mandatory rider's meeting will be held at 7pm to welcome all riders and get ready for the event.**

Remember – if you haven't already, you must download and join the race [Discord server](#). This is where we will communicate all race updates, and where you will send in your time-stamped photos for timekeeping. You can also post questions and contact race staff directly if needed.

Dokkan is open until 11pm, but we will start to break-down the race expo around 8pm to prepare for the week ahead.
