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### a Westfjords Way Challenge More than just a race

# 4 stages in 5 days

That means there are 5 nights to be organized as well. For those nights you can book accommodations provided by the race, arrange a room share with other riders, camp in the race campgrounds (camping gear will be transported by the race) or if you are traveling with a partner or someone who wants to explore the Westfjords in a car during the day, you can book a campervan rental and sleep there at the end of each stage.



Race accommodations will be handled by **Cycling Westfjords** through Tímataka page.

When you registere for the race you can book the accommodations too. You can also use your registration number later to access your booking and add accommodations later.

Accommodations are limited and must be **paid in full** when reserved. Room sharing is highly encouraged and we recommend purchasing a room and coordinating room-share with other riders through our social medias. It is also recommended to co-ordinate payment with other riders in advance of the race and **Cycling Westfjords is not responsible for room sharing arrangements made or payment of room-shares.** 

If you are the owner of a reservation, you may cancel your reservation and be refunded until May 15 2025.

### Sunday, June 22 - Monday, June 23 Isafjörður and also Saturday June 28

The race starts and ends in Ísafjörður,the largest town in the Westfjords. You may choose to arrive a day in advance of the race expo to explore Ísafjörður and the surrounding villages.

Accommodation Hotel Ísafjörður **Torfnes** is a summer hotel on two floors with 33 rooms for both double and triple rooms. The Hotel is well located about a 10-minute walk from the center of Ísafjörður.

The rooms are spacious and bright and all have a private bathroom. There is wireless internet throughout the house and the wireless internet is free. Check-in is from 15:00pm and check-out is at 11:00am.

**Breakfast** is served in the dining room from 07:00am to 10:00am, except of the race morning, then breakfast is served at **6am**.

There are **two campgrounds** in town, one is the the municipality campground and is located in the fjordbottom Túngudalur (about 15minutes cycling tour from town center), and the other one (not for campervans) by Torfnes hotel. Both with access to a bathroom, showers, and electricity.

#### Camping is paid on location to chosen campground.



### Tuesday, June 24 - Stage 1

Stage 1 ends at Hotel Laugarhóll in Bjarnafjörður. Hotel Laugarhóll is the main race hotel and is a family-run hotel in Bjarnarfjörður, a lush valley in Strandir. Built between 1963 and 1965,

the house was originally a boarding school for children from the age of 6 to 15. Dinner and breakfast will be served in Laugarhóll. At Laugarhóll there is a a lounge with free internet, a warm hot-spring swimming pool and a natural hot-tub.

We have three accommodation options i Bjarnafjörður; Laugarhóll, Svanshóll and Hvammur cottages. All within walking distance.

**Campground is included** for participants in the race fee and is located by the hotel Laugarhóll. Campervans are welcome as well, let us know if you have extra guests.

### Thursday June 26 and Friday June 27 Stage 3

Stage 3 ends in the town of Patreksfjörður. Rich Icelandic meatsoup (meatless for vegans) will be served at the **Race bacecamp** where the finish line is at 7 and wil be waiting for you whenever you arrive. **Breakfast** will also be served there and refreshments all day. The Icelandic plokkfiskur and rúgbrauð (Fish-stue and dark ruebread) will be served there too at **5pm on Friday**.

Accommodation options are spread out through the town, all near the Adventure Day basecamp, Hotel **West**, **Stekkaból** guesthouse and **Pálshús** guesthouse, <u>all for two nights</u>.

**Campground is included** for participants in the race fee and is located next to the race bacecamp with access to toilet, shower, and electricity. Campervans are welcome as well, let us know if you have extra guests.
