July 4 Adventure Day

On the morning of July 4, you can drop your bikes off at The Community Hall and Campground for storage while you take a rest or an adventure.

We will all meet up for a group fish fest lunch at The Community Hall at 4:00 pm.

Please note that anyone not registered as a racer or volunteer will need to purchase their meal ahead at the community hall. The cost for each person is 3.500 isk.

Other than the fish fest, food is up to you this day, but there will be a small continental-style breakfast available all day at the Community Hall. Ölgerðin drinks and Arna lactose-free dairy products will be available all day at the Community Hall as well.

We will prepare for a group rollout at midnight to begin Stage 4, so plan to meet and be ready to go at The Community Hall by 11:30 pm. A debrief will be held at 11:40 pm.

Here are some recommended day tours

<u>Westfjords Adventures</u> offers day trips and excursions. From puffins to seal watching, experience the furthest western reaches of Iceland. More info is available on their <u>website</u>.

We highly recommend the tour to the <u>Látrabjarg cliffs</u> – the largest seabird colony in the northern Atlantic and may just be the best place in the world to photograph puffins!

Another great option is the day trip to <u>Rauðisandur</u> – one of Iceland´s most famous beaches with its red colored sand, black cliffs and blue ocean.

You can also book kayaking tours, or if your legs are feeling up for it, ask about their self-guided bike tours!

And if you prefer to stay in town and take it easy, a trip to the Patreksfjörður pool shouldn't be missed. You're also free to spend time in the community center as it has been rented for the full day.
